And the said Catherine Bette being by me in due form of oath examined separately and apart from her said Husband and the full contents of the above deed being by me made known to her she the said Catherine Bette upon such separate examination as aforesaid declared that she did voluntarily and of her own free will and accord seal and as her act and deed deliver the said deed without any coercion or compulsion of her said Husband. In Testimony whereof I the said Justice have hereunto set my hand and seal at Sheringo Township the 4th day of March A.D. 1820

~~This Indenture made the Twentieth fifth day of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and Twenty Between Henry Broad of the Township of Sadsbury County of Bradford and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Abraham Cummings of the County and Commonwealth aforesaid of the one part and Abraham Cummings of the County and Commonwealth aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth That the said Henry Broad for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty dollars money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said Abraham Cummings at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt and payment whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and that of and forever discharge the said Abraham Cummings his executors and administrators by these presents hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed released and confirmed and by these presents will doo grant bargain sell alien convey release and confirm unto the said Abraham Cummings and to his heirs and assigns all that following piece or lot of ground situated in the Town of Harrisburg in the Township of Sadsbury County of Bradford aforesaid being numbered in the several plan of said Town number thirty (30) bounded on the East by a street west by S. S. N. E. Street South by a street alley and North by walnut street containing seventy five feet in width and East and West and extending one hundred and forty five feet on water street North and South it being a part of a larger tract of land which said tract was surveyed and patented to the said Henry Broad on the nineteenth day of September one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven to the said Henry Broad who he did give the fourth day of August one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight to the said Abraham Cummings by the said Henry Broad being recorded in the great book of the Commonwealth the third day of March A.D. 1812 one thousand eight hundred and twenty six page sixty seven to the said William Townes and by his deed of conveyance bearing date the seventeenth day of December A.D. one thousand seven hundred and twenty seven conveyed a certain tract of land about seven or seven hundred acres in Alleghany County now Bradford to the said Abraham Cummings the said Abraham Cummings conveyed two hundred acres of the East end of the above mentioned tract of land to the said Henry Broad bearing date the tenth day of May one thousand eight hundred and two recorded in the office for recording of deeds in and for the County of Bradford in deed book A page 373 the 13th day of July 1812 the said Henry Broad conveyed the above described tract of land to the said Abraham Cummings bearing date the fifth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six~~
