This Indenture made the fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty between Reason Belts of the County of Lewis and Clark Territory and James Wilson of the County of Lewis and Clark Territory of the one part and Reason Belts of the County of Lewis and Clark Territory of the other part. Whereas the commonwealth of Virginia by their patent of confirmation dated the 12th day of July A. D. 1799 recited in the said patent in words to the effect following did grant unto John Field William Bramson and James Wilson Trustees of the Pennsylvania Colonization Company a certain tract of land situate within the County of Lewis and Clark Territory and the said Managers of said Company by their attorney Thos. Allison do hereby certify the following description of the said tract of land unto the above named Thomas Allison Clerk of said County on the 28th day of October A. D. 1819 as reference may be made. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said James Wilson and his heirs in consideration of the natural love and affection which they have for and bear to their said son Reason Belts and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars to him paid by said Reason Belts the receipt whereof they hereby acknowledge and granted by deed to be sold unto the said Reason Belts the following described parcel of land situate lying and being at the North West corner of a single square lot of land surveyed by John Coloffin one hundred and sixty perches in length and bounded north by the portion of the whole said square and bounded east by the said single square surveyed land one hundred and sixty perches by a line of the said single square and bounded west by a line of the said single square and allowance of six feet for a road or passage to be had and to be held the same unto the said Reason Belts his heirs and assigns forever subject to the usual reservations made by the said James Wilson.

~~This Indenture made the Twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and Twenty Between Henry Broad of the Township of Saadbury County of Bradford and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Abraham Cummings of the County and Commonwealth aforesaid of the one part and Abraham Cummings of the County and Commonwealth aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth That the said Henry Broad for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty dollars money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said Abraham Cummings at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt and payment whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and that he doth and forever discharge the said Abraham Cummings his executors and administrators by these presents hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed released and confirmed and by these presents will do all grant bargain sell alien convey release and confirm unto the said Abraham Cummings and to his heirs and assigns all that following piece or lot of ground situated in the Town of Harrisburg in the Township of Saadbury County of Bradford aforesaid being numbered in the several plan of said Town number thirty (30) bounded on the East by a street west by S. C. Shiner Esquire South by a street alley and North by walnut street containing seventy five feet in width North East and West and extending one hundred and forty five feet on water street North and South it being a part of a larger tract of land which said tract was surveyed and patented of record under the thirtieth day of September one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven granted to Sarah Lewis who she did give the fourteenth day of August one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight to the above named Henry Broad by the said Alexander Lewis given from under the great seal of the Commonwealth the third day of March A.D. one thousand eight hundred and ten patent book number thirty six page sixty whereas William Towne did by his deed of conveyance bearing date the seventeenth day of December A.D. one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven conveyed a certain tract of land about seven or eight hundred acres in Alleghany County now Bradford to the said Abraham Cummings the said Alexander Lewis conveyed two hundred acres of the East end of the above mentioned tract of land to the said Henry Broad bearing date the thirteenth day of May one thousand eight hundred and two recorded in the office for recording of deeds in and for the County of Bradford in deed book A page 373. The 13th day of July 1812. The said Henry Broad did convey the above described tract of land to the said Abraham Cummings bearing date the thirtieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty.~~
