




"Miss Sherbondy" married James Richey per the Favette County History (page 328).

Unconnected Individuals

Henry Huston Sherbondy b. 1830 (<u>Clan H</u>) and Henry Harrison Sherbondy 1828-1884 (married Margaret Ann Sober) are the same person. The middle name Huston is on the birth record from the Denmark Manor Lutheran Church. The name (Henry) Harrison is only on the death certificate of his son David Harrison and in the family records of some descendants. These two have now been combined into <u>Clan H</u>.

Rosannah Sabanda married Ezekiel Parker on 10 July 1828 in Portage County, OH per the marriage record recorded Sept 1828. Rosanna Sherbondy Parker has been determined to be the youngest daughter of Melichor and Maria Sherbondy. Per review of the birth year sources and evidence of her living in Ohio. You can see her branch at <u>Clan F</u>.

George Washington Sherbondy b. 1834 (married Mary Ellen Miller) and Geo W. Sherbondy b. 1836-1837 (<u>Clan N</u>) have been identified as the same person. Go to <u>Clan N</u> to view their descendants.

W. W. Sherbondy b. 1838 and Wilder Sherbondy b. 1839 (<u>Clan U</u>) have been identified as the same person. Go to <u>Clan U</u> to view their descendants.
