

One Generation of Descendants of Homer Sherbondy (1118)



Homer Sherbondy

1. Homer SHERBONDY (1118)^{1,2,3,4,5,6,7} was born on 2 Oct 1836 in Akron, Summit, OH.^{8,2,9,10,11,12,13} He married Catherine M. Bort (1118) on 22 Aug 1857 in Tiskilwa, Bureau, IL.^{8,2,14,4} He died on 30 Sep 1900 in Council Bluffs, Pottawattamie, IA, at age 63.²

He was also known as H. Sherbondy (1118).^{15,16,8} He lived in 1850 in Portage, Summit, OH.¹⁷ He lived in 1857 in Bureau Co, IL.⁸ He and Catherine M. Bort (1118) lived in 1860 in Wheatland, Bureau, IL.^{4,3} He lived in Aug 1862 in Cambridge, IL.³ He began military service on 9 Aug 1862 in Cambridge, IL³ in 112th Regiment Company C, IL, as Private.^{16,8,6} He was in a regiment mustered Sep 1862 into U.S. service in Peoria, IL.³ He was promoted to Full Lieutenant 2nd Class.³ He was in Civil War battles on 18 Sep 1863 in Chickamauga, GA³, on 26 Oct 1863 in Philadelphia, TN³, between 17 Nov 1863 and 18 Nov 1863 in Knoxville, TN³, in Riceville, TN³, on 14 Dec 1863³, between 28 Jan 1864 and 29 Jan 1864 in Kelly Ford, VA³ and in the Siege of Knoxville under General Burnside's in Resaca, Tennessee in May 1864.⁸ He was wounded by gun shot in the left arm and lung on 20 May 1864 in Good Hope Church, GA.⁸ He was in a Civil War battle on 8 Jul 1864 in Marietta, GA.³ He was in the Battle of Franklin, Tennessee on 29 Nov 1864.⁸ He was taken prisoner at the battle of Franklin, Tennessee on 30 Nov 1864.⁸ He was in a Civil War battle on 15 Jan 1865 in Florence, SC.³ He was an Anderson Prisoner for four months and seven days and was sent to Vicksburg on 18 Mar 1865 in Vicksburg, PA.^{16,8} He ended military service 15 May 1865 as Second Lieuten.^{8,3} He ended military service on 15 May 1865 (discharge date).³

He and Catherine M. Bort (1118) lived in 1870 in Washington, Keokuk, IA.⁴ He was a farmer in 1870 in Washington, Keokuk, IA.¹⁵ He was in Mercantile, Jewelry store, Drug store and other businesses between May 1870 and 1876 in What Cheer, IA.^{8,18} He was friends and neighbors of John Marquis and Mary Ann Brunt. John Marquis Brunt also served with Homer in the war (33rd Iowa Infantry starting Aug 1862 (per 1222E)). They named their son after Homer, "Homer Sherbondy Brunt", on 2 Nov 1870 in Sigourney, IA.^{19,20} He was the creator of the Sherbondy artifact, Sherbondy & Son, What Cheer, IA pocket watch. This was to advertise his jewelry store, drug store and/or other successful businesses he owned with his son Byron in the 1870's. This pocket watch is featured on the artifacts web page of the Sherbondy Family Association.²¹ He was Mining and discovered the Little Ellen mines (a rich copper vein) in 1876 in Leadville, CO.^{8,22} He for a large remuneration on 18 Aug 1876 sold in the Little Ellen mines, Leadville, CO.⁸ He and Catherine M. Bort (1118) lived between Oct 1879 and 1880 in a nice farm of 80 acres, What Cheer, Keokuk, IA.^{5,8} He was a stock dealer in 1880 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA.⁵ He lived in 1881 in NE.¹

Catherine M. BORT (1118)⁸ was born on 28 Aug 1840 in NY.^{2,18,9,23,24} She was born between 1842 and 1843 in NY (age 37 in 1880 census).⁵ She died on 25 May 1909 in Council Bluffs, Pottawattamie, IA, at age 68.^{2,25} She was also known as Catharine (1118).⁴ She was also known as Catharina (1118).¹⁵ She was also known as Cate (1118).⁵

Children of Homer Sherbondy (1118) and Catherine M. Bort (1118) were as follows:

- 2 i. Byron SHERBONDY (11181)^{2,8,4,15,5} was born between 1858 and 1859 in IL (age 1 in 1860 census, age 11 in 1870 census).^{4,15} He was born on 16 Nov 1859 in IL (age 20 in 1880 census, age 40 in 1900 census).^{2,5,9} He married Hattie McKeen (11181) on 3 Nov 1886.^{2,26}

He lived in 1860 in Wheatland, Bureau, IL.⁴ He lived in 1870 in Washington, Keokuk, IA.¹⁵ He lived in 1880 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA.⁵ He and Hattie McKeen (11181) had two children.²⁷ He and Warren Sherbondy (11186) lived in Jun 1900 in Prairie City Town, Grant, OR.⁹ He was a Gold Miner in Jun 1900 in Union, Grant, OR.⁹ As of Jun 1900, he was also known as Byron SHERBONDEY (11181).⁹

- Hattie MCKEEN (11181)^{2,28} died on 2 Jun 1925 in Medina County, OH.²⁸ She lived in Lake City, IA.¹⁸
- 3 ii. Florence SHERBONDY (11182)^{8,2,18,15,5,29} was born on 12 Feb 1860.² She was born between 1861 and 1862 in IL (age 18 in 1880 census).⁵ She was born between 1862 and 1863 in IL (age 7 in 1870 census).¹⁵ She married Al Forrester (11182).² She married Mort Sperry (11182).² She married Warren Wortman (11182).^{2,18}
- She lived in 1870 in Washington, Keokuk, IA.¹⁵ She lived in 1880 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA.⁵ She lived in 1900 in Akron, Summit, OH.²⁹
- Al FORRESTER (11182)² lived in Helena, MT.¹⁸
- 4 iii. Genevive SHERBONDY (11183)² was born between 1866 and 1867 in IA (age 13 in 1880 census).⁵ She was born between 1866 and 1867 in IA (age 3 in 1870 census).¹⁵ She was born in Oct 1866 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA.² She died on 9 Sep 1881 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA, at age 14.^{2,30,31}
- She was also known as Ugenie SHERBONDY (11183).¹⁵ She was also known as Jenny (11183).⁵ She lived in 1870 in Washington, Keokuk, IA.¹⁵ As of 1880, she was also known as Jennie (11183).⁸ She lived in 1880 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA.⁵
- 5 iv. Adalade SHERBONDY (11184)² was born on 20 Feb 1867 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA.² She was born between 1868 and 1869 in IA (age 11 in 1880 census).⁵ She married Samuel E. Whaley (11184).^{2,18}
- She was also known as Aada (11184).⁵ She was also known as Adelaide (11184).¹⁸ As of 1880, she was also known as Addie (11184).⁸ She lived in 1880 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA.⁵
- 6 v. Marguerite Myrtle SHERBONDY (11185)^{2,32} was born on 18 Oct 1875 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA (age 4 in 1880 census).^{2,5} She married James Vincent Ryan (11185).² She and James Vincent Ryan (11185) were divorced in 1908.³² She married Daniel Brown Woodland (11185) (2nd husband).² She died on 2 Oct 1943 in Provo, Utah, UT, at age 67.²
- She and Warren Sherbondy (11186) were twins.⁸ She lived in 1880 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA.⁵ As of 1880, she was also known as Maggie (11185).⁸ As of 1880, she was also known as Magie (11185).⁵ She and James Vincent Ryan (11185) resided between 1900 and 1908 in Ogden, UT.³²

- James Vincent RYAN (11185)^{2,32} was born on 17 Nov 1871 in San Juan, San Juan, Puerto Rico.² He died on 12 Sep 1921 in Salt Lake City, Salt Lake, UT, at age 49.^{2,33}
- 7 vi. Warren SHERBONDY (11186)^{8,18,34,5,2,35} was born on 18 Oct 1875 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA ().^{2,36,34,37,38,35} He married Florence Covalt (11186) on 28 Sep 1904 in At home, Council Bluffs, IA.^{2,18,31} He died on 12 Feb 1940 in Council Bluffs, IA, at age 64.^{31,34} He was buried on 14 Feb 1940 in Cedar Lawn Cemetary, Council Bluffs, IA (Wednesday).^{36,34}
- He was also known as Warren Eugene SHERBONDY (11186).³⁹ He and Marguerite Myrtle Sherbondy (11185) were twins.⁸ He lived in 1880 in What Cheer, Keokuk, IA.⁵ He and Byron Sherbondy (11181) lived in Jun 1900 in Prairie City Town, Grant, OR.⁹ As of Jun 1900, he was also known as Warren SHERBONDEY (11186).⁹ He was occup1 a Gold Miner in Jun 1900 in Union, Grant, OR.⁹ He was Cashier & Office manager at International Harvester Co.³⁶ He was described as medium height, medium build, brown eyes, brown hair in 1918.³⁵ He was a cashier at International Harvester Co of America in 1918 in Omaha, NE.³⁵ He and Florence Covalt (11186) resided in Sep 1918 in Council Bluffs, IA.³⁵ He registered for military service on 12 Sep 1918.³⁵
- Florence COVALT (11186)^{2,18} was born on 12 Aug 1883 in Council Bluffs, IA.³⁶ She died in 1970 in Council Bluffs, IA.³⁶ She was buried in Cedar Lawn Cemetary, Council Bluffs, IA.³⁶
