Life in PA in the 1750's As per this biography of Philip and Catherina Bossard (parents of Maria Catherina)	1750's	German roots	Johann Cherpantier and Jacob Zimmerman records point to German ancestry. DNA records link them both. Johann and Jacob both settled in German communities in the US.

John Sherbandie took the Oath of Allegiance in Northampton County, PA	16 Jan 1778	14 May 1778	John Sharpentey enrolled in Northampton County, PA Militia to fight in Revolutionary War.
